



## Spreyton School MFL Overview

As we a very small school at Spreyton we have a unique challenge to ensure that all children make progress at their own level, and have a pathway through our curriculum that supports their learning at an appropriate level for their year group, while being taught in a class with 4 year groups.

We have chosen to teach French as our Modern Foreign Language, as our closest neighbour and the country most likely to be visited by children on holiday, and also due to staff expertise.

We use the grammarsaurus curriculum to teach French, and have arranged the units of work so they build logically through the year, with units that require prior knowledge being taught in the same academic year, to ensure progression through the year without the chance of any one year group doing a unit before they've done the prior learning required for it. So, each year the children have one or two themes which build progressively through the year. We have built in revision at the beginning of each academic year to ensure Y3 children are equipped with the basic knowledge before moving on, and to allow practice and repetition to cement learning for years 4/5/6, and for children who are new to the school.
